FLAT RATE (SEWER CUSTOMERS ONLY)

Charge: \$45.53 per month

Multi-unit facilities of Three or more are billed a unit fee (X no. of units) of \$8.13 for water and \$8.13 for sewer.

***Residential customers have 3/4" pipe size.**

Per Environmental Protection Agency guidelines, we are required to make an annual public disclosure of water and sewer rates.

For your convenience, there is a drop box located at the right side of City Hall doors for after hour/weekend/holiday bill payments. You may also use automated payment from your financial institution by signing a form obtained at City Hall.

Residential Garbage Collection for Rogers City Residents:

Garbage Rates:

Basic Service (one bag or one can ONLY)	\$4.85/month
Full Service (six bags or three cans)	\$9.75/month
Cart Service (95-gallon wheeled cart)*	\$10.25/month

*Cart must be rented from PAC, Inc. at an additional fee. Trash selection form must be filled out and presented to City Hall prior to contacting PAC for rental of the cart. Call 989-733-2598 for this service.

Selection of level of service will remain in force until July 1, 2016.

No bag/garbage can is to exceed 35 gal in capacity and 50 lbs. in weight.

Trash must be placed at curbside no later than **7 a.m.** on collection day.

Residential waste pickup is on **THURSDAY** of each week. On the first Thursday of each month, PAC, Inc. **will pick up one (1) bulky item** at no additional cost. Garbage pickup will always be on Thursday unless the Holiday falls on Thursday, which will move the pickup day to Friday of that week.

Residential Waste: Only waste and refuse commonly produced by persons living in a residence is allowed.

Unacceptable Waste: Yard waste, branches from trees and shrubs, dirt, concrete, large vehicle parts, car batteries, used motor oil, liquid waste, tires, freon, and hazardous and special waste (as defined by state and federal statutes and regulations).

Yard Waste: Yard waste (grass and leaves) will be accepted at the Transfer Station compost pile with no charge to residents. State Law prohibits yard waste to be dumped in a landfill.

Transfer Station Hours:

Summer	Thursday	3 p.m. to 6 p.m.
	Saturday	8 a.m. to 2 p.m.
Winter	Saturday	8 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Recycling: There is no fee for recyclables. Containers will be provided at the Transfer Station for acceptable recyclables.
